



My Meals. My Way.

Between classes, studying, going to work, and your social life, who has time to get an affordable, healthy meal in a convenient time frame? Take a break! Use your BGSU Meal Plan to eat what you want, when you want, and how you want! As a residential student living in traditional housing at Bowling Green State University, you are required to purchase a meal plan which gives you healthy, delicious and convenient dining options throughout campus. Just present your student ID at entry and, voila, it's your meal, your way.

Steps in choosing the right meal plan

Traditional and Retail Explained

Traditional/ACE

A "meal" constitutes one visit to a traditional dining facility and one swipe with your student ID. You can stay as long as you like, and eat whatever you like during your visit. You can use your meals anytime during open hours during that week. The meals roll over from day to day but do not roll over from week to week.

Traditional/ACE meals will be offered at the new The Oaks Dining Center (opening Fall 2011) and the new Carillon Dining Center (opening Fall 2011/Spring 2012). * Selections in the new facilities are always changing, offering new choices every day, so your dining experience never gets old. This dining plan helps you build friendships on campus and is more environmentally friendly with full china service and trayless dining. This plan does not include carryout, however students on the Traditional/ACE Plan have the ability to choose a meal equivalency option in select convenience stores. For those with retail plans, Traditional/ACE meals may be purchased with Falcon Dollars but will be at a slightly higher price point.

* We will continue to communicate with students and families about the progress of the new dining facilities.

Retail Plans

All Retail Plans consist of Falcon Dollars and are "declining balance" and "a la carte," meaning you pay only for what you take to the register. The price of the items purchased will be deducted from your balance of Falcon Dollars. These dollars may be used in any of the retail locations including the convenience stores, locations within the Bowen-Thompson Student Union*, residential dining locations, and may also be used to purchase all you care to eat - ACE meals.** Falcon Dollars will roll over from fall to spring semester, but expire at the end of the spring semester.

Custom Plans

Select a Custom Plan, which offers a combination of Traditional/ACE and Retail Plans, to create more flexibility.

Do any of my meals or dollars roll over?

Meals within the Traditional/ACE Plans and the Custom Plans may be used at any point during a week. They must be used by the end of the week or will be forfeited.

Falcon Dollars within the Custom Plan and the Retail Plan do roll over from fall semester to spring semester, but if not used by the end of the spring semester, they will expire.

What is a swipe?

A swipe is when a student with a Traditional/ACE or Custom meal plan presents an ID to enter an all you care to eat facility. This swipe constitutes the use of one "meal."

What is a meal equivalency?

We understand that there are times it might not be feasible for a student with a Traditional/



ACE Plan to make time to visit one of the all you care to eat facilities due to scheduling conflicts or class locations. Because of this, there will be an option at Outtakes at the Oaks and Outtakes at Carillon Place where you may use a swipe to purchase a pre-determined on-the-go meal.

Can I visit an all you care to eat facility if I have a Retail Plan?

Yes! If you have the Retail Plan you may use Falcon Dollars to purchase an all you care to eat meal.

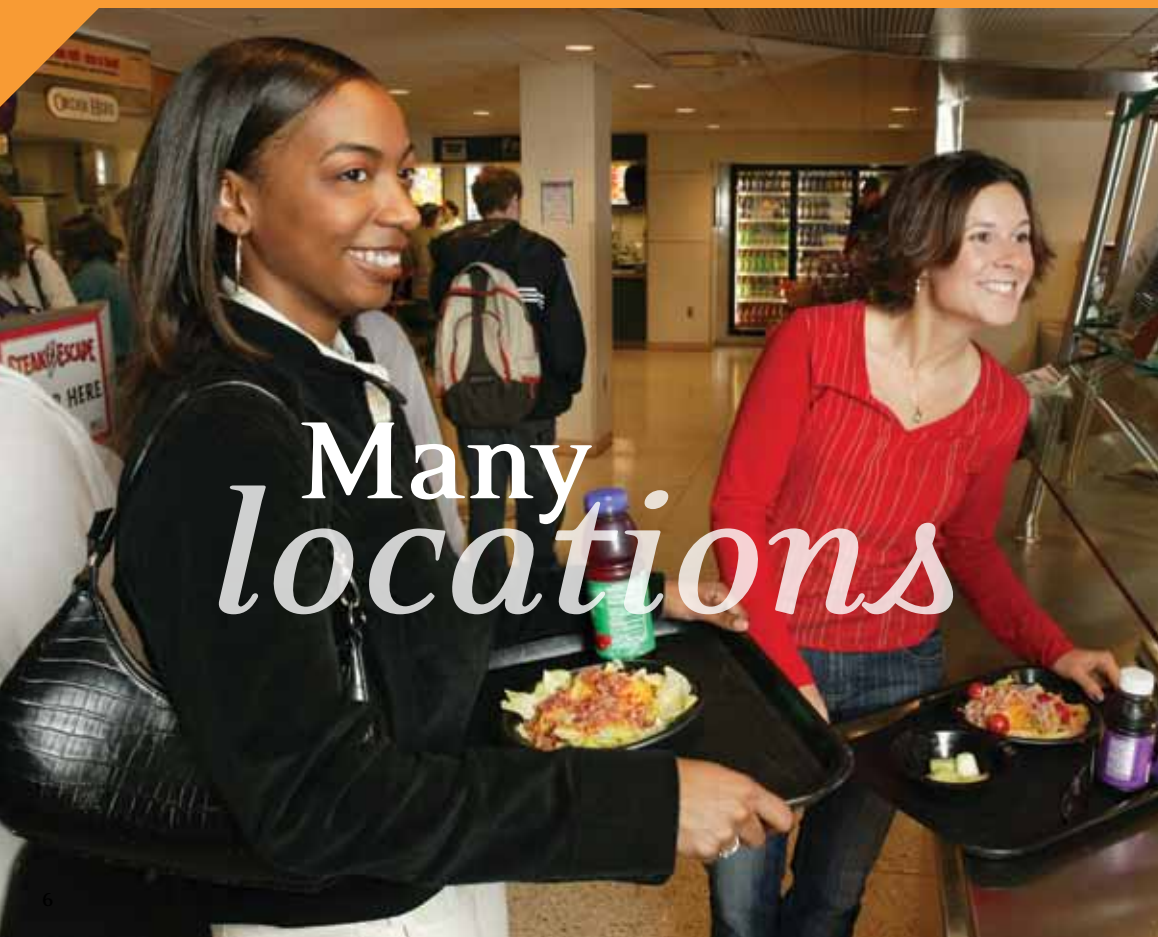
What if I run out of Falcon Dollars?
